The motion carried. (3-0-0).

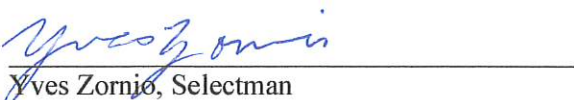
