Assessing Clerk Michelle Lutz prepared the State & Federal Forest Report for 2022, which needs to be submitted to the NH Department of Revenue Equalization Bureau. The report stated that the Mascot Mine Area has an assessed value of \$9,400, Moose Brook State Park has an assessed value of \$1,280,700 and the White Mountain National Forest has an assessed value of \$4,770,700.
