Fire and EMS personnel finished off the summer months staying busy responding to several motor vehicle accidents. Responses included the following:

- 1. Route 16 South for a car versus motorcycle with severe injuries to the rider.
- 2. Route 16 South for a car into the guardrails with no injuries.
- 3. Lancaster Road for a head on collision with one injured occupant.
- 4. Cascade Flats for a driver thrown off a dirt bike.

We would like to take this time to thank our fellow Public Safety personnel from Jackson who assisted with the motorcycle accident and provided life saving interventions prior to our arrival on scene. Working together with personnel from other towns happens often in our area as we all work together to help our patients.

Now is also a good time to talk about the upcoming winter season. As much as we may not want to believe it, snow will be here before we know it. Take the time now to ensure your car's tires are ready for winter travel and plan accordingly if travel is necessary during inclement weather.

Fire Chief/Emergency Management/Code Enforcement

During the month of August, we were notified by FEMA that we were awarded an Assistance to Firefighters grant which will allow us to purchase 22 mobile radios, 10 pagers, 4 mobile radios, and 1 base radio. This grant will provide funding of over \$98k with a 5% match.
