Fire and EMS:

Members of the Department started off the new year by staying busy responding to calls for assistance. In what has become more common this year we once again responded to Route 16 in Pinkham's Grant for a two-vehicle head on collision. Crews were assisted by personnel from Jackson Fire and Bartlett-Jackson Ambulance as three patients were transported to the hospital in Berlin. Crews stood by until both vehicles were towed from the scene. Below is a picture of one of the vehicles involved.



That same day crews responded to a school bus rear-ended by a pickup and a fire alarm activation at Wildcat Ski Area. Ambulance personnel also responded to two other calls in between these. As the winter rolls on we remind everyone to use caution as snow and ice still causes issues when traveling.
