Fire and EMS

Fire and EMS personnel worked through June with a typical call volume as we entered the busy summer season. We responded to several motor vehicle accidents all fortunately with minor injuries. We also assisted in a carryout of a patient who was hiking off the Auto Road and fell which resulted in several cuts to his forehead and legs.

We assisted Randolph Fire with a head on motor vehicle collision on Gorham Hill which resulted in 3 patient transports for further care. EMS personnel responded with both ambulances and transported two of the patients. Lancaster EMS responded to the scene for the third patient while Berlin covered another call in Shelburne for us at the same time.

Training

Fire department personnel continued to expand our swift water rescue training as crews used the boat in Libby Pool in preparation for moving to the river for further work. Crews practiced pulling people onboard the boat and other basic skills that are necessary during a water rescue.

Truck drivers and other personnel use apparatus to practice drafting out of our dry hydrants and static water sources. These water sources can be invaluable in areas without hydrants and if an emergency were to occur that overwhelmed the municipal water supply. EMS personnel spent an evening with our Mutual Aid partners from Milan and Dummer EMS reviewing each other's ambulances and available equipment. Performing these types of trainings helps us to work together on large scenes if the need arises.
