

TOWN OF GORHAM

Transfer Station Permit Policy

Effective July 1, 2020, Gorham property owners/residents will be required to obtain a Transfer Station Permit. The Sticker Application Form will be available at the Town Clerk/Tax Collector's office and on the Town's website, www.gorhamnh.org, under the Highway Department/Transfer Station Tab/Sticker Permit (menu on left side).

Upon completion and submission of the Transfer Station Sticker Application Form along with payment of a \$5.00 permit fee to the Town Clerk/Tax Collector, up to two permits will be issued per property. Stickers will be valid for three (3) years from July 1st. The sticker shall be displayed on the passenger-side, lower corner of the windshield of the residents'/business owner's vehicle.

Stickers can also be obtained by mail by completing the form (found online at www.gorhamnh.org as noted above) and sending the form along with a check payable to the Town of Gorham along with a "Self-Addressed, Stamped" envelope to: Town Clerk, Town of Gorham, 20 Park Street, Gorham, NH 03581.

For any residents/business owners who have large loads of solid waste/building debris (pickup truck full or larger), you will be required to obtain a permit from the Public Works Office to bring the solid waste/building debris directly to the solid waste district, Androscoggin Valley Regional Refuse Disposal District (AVRRDD).

For any contractors that own or rent property in the Town of Gorham, you may apply for a transfer station permit. You will be issued a permit and allowed to drop off small amounts of solid waste/building debris at the Transfer Station. For any full pickup truck (or larger) loads, you will be required to obtain a permit from the Public Works Office to bring the solid waste/building debris directly to the solid waste district, AVRRDD.

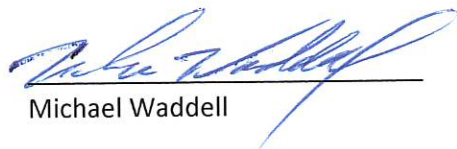
For any contractors who are from out-of-town and do not own or rent property in the Town of Gorham, you will be required to bring the solid waste/building debris directly to the solid waste district, AVRRDD.

For transfer station permit holders, the Transfer Station will continue to accept cardboard, magazines, brush, leaves, metal, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, refrigerators and freezers.

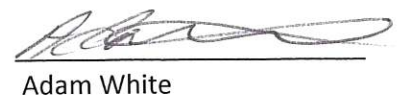
Requirement of Transfer Station Sticker for entry to the Gorham Transfer Station to be enforced effective, September 1, 2020:
