Programs Descriptions:

Instructional (Preschool – Grade 1): Instruction will be provided by the Gorham High School Varsity Soccer Team and Coaches. Emphasis will be on skills and techniques to learn the game of soccer. Schedule of practices will be announced later. Sessions will be held at the Libby Recreation Complex Soccer Field. Children must be 4 years old by 9/30/23 to participate.

Grades 1 & 2 Coed: This league will consist of 6-a-side soccer. Teams play on a smaller field using smaller goals. Emphasis will be placed on proper techniques, proper positions and understanding the rules of the game. Games will be played at the Ed Fenn Field & Milan.

Grades 3 & 4 Coed: This league will consist of 7-a-side soccer. Teams will play on medium sized field using medium sized goals. Emphasis will be placed on proper techniques, team building, individual skills, and game rules. Games will be played at Libby Softball Field & Milan.

Grades 5 & 6 Coed: This league will consist of 7-a-side soccer. Teams will play on medium sized field using medium sized goals. Emphasis will be placed on proper techniques, team building, individual skills, set plays on offense and defense. These skills will prepare players for a more competitive travel team league. Games will be played at Libby Softball Field & Milan.

Grade 5 & 6 Travel Teams: Players will be selected from our “in-house” teams. 6th grade players will be selected first. 5th grade players will only be asked to play if players are needed to fill out the roster (typically 15 players per roster). Travel teams will attend tournaments in conjunction with our regular “in-house” season. Tournaments are typically held on weekends.
