## **Work Session**

The board met with Tara Bamford to continue with the process of updating the Master Plan. Topic of discussion centered on the land use chapter. The board had a long discussion regarding private roads and whether the Town should allow building on them or not. Tara will bring some examples of private road ordinances for the board to review. Gorham is one of the few towns in New Hampshire that does not yet allow building on private roads. There were some areas of the zoning map that the board may wish to change to allow for future development. Some areas are timber & agriculture with residential zones on either side. Perhaps the board may want to consider changing those areas. Another area to consider changing is to extend the Commercial Compact zone from just Exchange Street to go along Main Street and possibly widen the commercial zones along Main Street instead of having Commercial uses allowed only on lots directly abutting Main Street. Lots can actually be split into two zoning districts.
