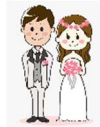

## Vehicles

The **cost of registering a vehicle**, is based off these **3 things....**

\***Year**.....Newer=more expensive

\***Weight**.....Heavier=more expensive

\***List Price=MSRP**.....Higher cost=more expensive

All **electric plug in vehicles** have a **\$100 State fee** applied when registering. All **hybrid vehicles** have a **\$50 State fee** applied when registering. This was put into effect starting September 1, 2023. All of this charge, **goes to the State, not the town.**
