Are you buying a used trailer or vehicle from an individual?

Here are some tips to make sure that we will be able to **Title and Register** this trailer or vehicle in your name.

Trailers

*If you are buying a **trailer** that has a **GVW of over 3,000 Lbs. and has a model year of a 2000 or newer, make sure that the seller has a title in THEIR name.** New Hampshire DMV requires any trailer over 3,000 Lbs. to be titled. If the seller does not have a title in their name to sign over to you, you will not be able to title and register the trailer in your name.

*Any trailer that has a **GVW of 3,000 LBS. or less, is exempt from a title,** but will need a bill of sale that includes the **VIN #, Make, Year, Weight, and Color.**

Vehicles

*If you are buying a **vehicle** from an individual, you will need a title with the seller's name on it, signed over to you. **Make sure the odometer is recorded before you come to the Clerk's office.**

*A **vehicle** is **exempt from having a title** if it is a model year of **1999 or older.** In this case, you will need to have one of the following, a copy of the current or past registration, copy of a title, vin verification or a bill of sale that meets all the requirements.

***Anyone who is on the title as a buyer, has to be here in the office to sign the title work. Whoever is on the title will be on the registration.**
