Weekly Reports July 15 & July 22, 2022

New signs posted on site and notice in the paper regarding:

Due to the increased volume being brought to the transfer station to be disposed of in the dumpster, all loads that fill a 6-foot pickup truck bed or larger will have to be delivered by the resident directly to the Androscoggin Valley Regional Refuse Disposal District (AVRRDD). Please note that a permit needs to be issued by the Public Works Garage in advance of going to AVRRDD. Household garbage (kitchen waste) will continue to be accepted. This policy will take effect as of Friday, March 27th. If you have a large volume of items to be disposed of, it is a good idea to call ahead to speak with Lisa at 603-466-5025 to be sure that it can be accepted, or to have an alternate time scheduled to bring it in.

WORK PERFORMED:

Daily cleaning and disinfecting all work vehicles and work areas to prevent sickness.

Catch-basin repair at Cascade Intersection; Paving work done by Blaktop Paving Co.

Paving project done on Marion Way; Blaktop Paving was hired to do the work.

Installed new catch-basin on the corner of Hitchcock Drive and Bangor Street.

Trimmed brush overgrowth along the sidewalks.

Hauled leaves to Mt. Carberry.

Mowing continues the town common, town parks, airport area-multi-modal, and Cascade.

If time permits, we have a yard guy on hand to work the building grounds and make trips to AVRRDD with fluorescent bulbs, batteries, and various recycling items.

Total number of Permits for AVRRDD written for 2 weeks: 3

Cemeteries: Continuous mowing and maintenance at the cemeteries.
Burial held at the Lary Cemetery.

MSW/Recycling/Sanitation:

- Monday garbage and cardboard collected: 1 Sanitation Driver, 3 pieces of equipment and 2 crew members.

- Wednesday Trash collection and recyclables.
- Thursday recycling.
- Friday recycling; businesses and school garbage collection.
