
MINUTES: Water & Sewer Commission Meeting

DATE: 21 September 2020 TIME: 4:00 PM

PRESENT: Jeff Tennis, Lee Carroll, Roger Goulet, and Ted Miller

- Reviewed meeting minutes of 8 September 2020 Water and Sewer Commission Meeting and signed same.
- Reviewed invoices and signed same.
- **Reviewed Administrative Cost for Shut Offs** of 11 September 2020 in the amount of \$37.50 and signed same.
- **Reviewed Supplemental Commitments** of 9 September 2020, 11 September 2020, and 15 September 2020 in respective amounts of \$92.72, \$91.46, and \$101.62 and signed same.
- **Reviewed Shut Off** list of 9 September 2020 and signed same.
- **Reviewed Water Capital Reserve Payment** of \$24,763.85 to Cummins Sales and Service for repairs to Generator at Well #2. Signed same.
- **Reviewed Sewer Capital Reserve Payment** of \$828.00(40%) to Cues for repairs to Auto Crane. Signed same.
- **Reviewed Water Capital Reserve Payment** of \$1,240.00(60%) to Cues for repairs to Auto Crane. Signed same.
- **Well #2 Generator** repairs completed.
- **Assisted Fire Department on 15 September 2020** by moving vehicles to help with their training. Also crushed dumpster for Highway Department at their request on 14 September 2020.
- **Awaiting NHDES communication** regard PFOS materials testing reactivation and requirements for the Department based on past test data provided.
- **Discussed Promenade Street** sewer p/s. More to come on this as it is in initial phase at this time.
- **Discussed possible property other end of Promenade Street**, where new property owner may want to go with municipal Water & Sewer instead of present well and septic. In initial stage at this time.
- **Discussed Selectman's approval of glider pilots** camping (up to 8) this fall at Airport. Water & Sewer was not contacted prior to this, as was supposed to occur. Commission considers this a potential liability to Town's water supply.
- **WWTF has foaming problem.** Kurt has contacted NHDES regarding suggestions. We remain in compliance with EPA discharge permit. NHDES will also send representative to see if they have suggestions to cure issue.
- **Discussed initial Town policy revisions** being considered. Commissioners will consider how and if they will modify Water & Sewer Policy after Town completes and adopts their changes.
- **Discussed possible street work** for next summer. Need specific list of streets From Highway Department so Department can determine capability to redo Water & Sewer where needed.
- The next Commission Meeting is 5 October 2020 at 4:00 PM.
- There was no non-public session at this meeting.
